

FORMAT FOR PAPERS FOR ENAEE CONFERENCE.

1. Print and Pagination

The whole paper must be typed in Times New Roman type (like these instructions) on A4 size paper single sided, leaving a left-hand margin of at least 40mm and a right hand margin of at least 20mm. Each page should be numbered centrally at the bottom of the page and about 20mm above the edge of the page. The paper must not exceed 8 pages.

2. Title

The title should be up to 150mm in width, centred and 14 point bold typescript.

3. Authors' Name(s)

The authors' name, affiliation and email address should be centred under the title in 14 point bold typescript.

4. Summary.

A Summary not exceeding 300 words should precede the main text as an integral part of the paper. It should be printed or typed in 10 point single spacing.

5. Main text

The main text should be written using 12 point typescript, single spacing,

6. References

References should be provided in the following format:

Surname and initials of author, title of paper, book or publication, name and city of publisher, year of publication, volume number, page numbers.

Example

FOWLER R, **Understanding Language**, Routledge, London 1974, Vol.2, pp, 26-34.

7. Submission and deadlines

A preliminary text of the paper must be submitted as a word file as an email attachment to info@eur-ace.eu by **30 June 2013** at the latest.

The final text, taking into account possible notes by the Conference Programme Committee, must reach the same email address by **20 August 2013**.
